1. Everything Joseph went through (Genesis 37-50)

You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives. - Genesis 50:20

2. David and Bathsheba - Solomon came out of this relationship. He built the temple where that Ark or the covenant was kept. (2 Samuel 11-12)

In the eleventh year in the month of Bul, the eighth month, the temple was finished in all its details according to its specifications. He had spent seven years building it.- **1 Kings 6:38**

3. Sampson killing more of the enemies in his death than when he was alive. He was captured by them. (Judges 13-16)

Then Samson reached toward the two central pillars on which the temple stood. Bracing himself against them, his right hand on the one and his left hand on the other, Samson said, "Let me die with the Philistines!" Then he pushed with all his might, and down came the temple on the rulers and all the people in it. Thus he killed many more when he died than while he lived. - Judges 16:29-30

4. Paul and Silas in jail when the earthquake hit. He saved the jailers entire family. (Acts 16)

The jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household." Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all the others in his house. At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then immediately he and all his household were baptized. The jailer brought them into his house and set a meal before them; he was filled with joy because he had come to believe in God—he and his whole household. - Acts 16:29-34

1. Daniel being thrown in the lion den. The King said all the people are to pray to Daniels God.

Then King Darius wrote to all the nations and peoples of every language in all the earth: "May you prosper greatly! "I issue a decree that in every part of my kingdom people must fear and reverence the God of Daniel. "For he is the living God and he endures forever; his kingdom will not be destroyed, his dominion will never end. He rescues and he saves; he performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth. He has rescued Daniel from the power of the lions." — Daniel 6:25-27

2. David wasn't even called in when Samuel was looking for the next king... but God wanted him to be king.

Jesse had seven of his sons pass before Samuel, but Samuel said to him, "The Lord has not chosen these." So he asked Jesse, "Are these all the sons you have?" "There is still the youngest," Jesse answered. "He is tending the sheep." Samuel said, "Send for him; we will not sit down until he arrives." So he sent for him and had him brought in. He was glowing with health and had a fine appearance and handsome features. Then the Lord said, "Rise and anoint him; this is the one." So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and from that day on the Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon David. Samuel then went to Ramah. —1 Samu3l 16:10-13

3. Job lost it all. But recovered twice as much.

The Lord blessed the latter part of Job's life more than the former part. He had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, a thousand yoke of oxen and a thousand donkeys. And he also had seven sons and three daughters. **Job 42:12-13**

4. Apostle Paul - His entire life was turned around.

Paul approved the stoning of Stephen and was on a mission to persecute Christians. He was a good Pharisee, knew the bible and sincerely believed that the Christian movement was dangerous to Judaism.

He had an encounter with Jesus on the way to Damascus in Acts 9 and after that encounter was converted and began to preach that Jesus is the Son of God

Acts 9:17-20

Paul continued to Preach about Jesus and ended up writing almost half (13 of the 28 books) of the New Testament.

Weekly Prayer Plan - How to overcome Temptations & Sin

1. <u>DRAWING NEAR TO GOD</u> - Matt. 6:9 "This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name"

God the Father is the focus of all our prayers. We should never forget what a privilege it is to bend our knees on earth and reach almighty God in heaven.

2. CONFESSION - Matt. 6:12 "Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us"

When we repent and forgive others, we maintain fellowship with God. But if we hold grudges, that fellowship is broken. God loves to answer our prayers when the lines of communication are not disrupted.

3. **GOD CENTERED PETITIONS** Matt 6:10 "Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven."

Prayer should reflect a desire to align ourselves with God's goals and purposes, not to get Him to follow our plans.

4. PERSONAL PETITIONS Matt 6:11 "Give us today our daily bread."

We are dependent upon the Lord for our needs and He wants us to come to Him with our requests.

5. <u>MEDITATION</u> Joshua 1:8 "Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful."

Meditation is thinking about the word of God to understand what it means in the context of the scripture and how it can apply to your life today. The Word of God is powerful enough to still be relevant in your life today even though it was written thousands of years ago.

Read through the scripture passages for today as listed below:

Meditational Verses

Monday: Acts 9

Tuesday: Genesis 37 Wednesday: Genesis 39 Thursday: Genesis 40 Friday: Genesis 50

- **6. PRAISE & THANKSGIVING 1 John 5:14-15** "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us— whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him."

We can end our prayer time with confidence that God has heard our prayer and will answer in His perfect timing. Demonstrate your faith in Him by showing thanks before you see the answer to your prayers.
